2 When applying the floral tape, be sure to weave it through the provided notches to avoid slipping.

3 For a corsage or boutonniere with a shorter stem, simply clip the easy pin shorter at or below this line.

1 In your package of easy pins you will soon find that each pin is made up of two pieces. There is the pin itself and a rubber backing.

Please leave the backing in place. You will notice a small space between the easy pin and the rubber backing. This allows for easy removal by the customer. Please do not push the pins in further.

6 In the event that the corsage is particularly large, two easy pins can be used to add extra strength.

4 Leave approximately 1/2 of an inch between the pins and the end of the floral tape. This will allow for flexibility in applying the easy pin to the clothing.

5 To attach the corsage or boutonniere to the lapel simply pierce the fabric with the easy pin and apply the rubber backing to hold it in place.
